As I have been saying, the most important objective is for AIPC to become an ‘outside’ facing organisation where we connect the party with external working-class professionals through issues, events, campaigns rather than an excessive focus on internal party programs and activities.

I am very glad that this shift is gathering significant traction through our domain-focused structure, events with professionals and taking up their causes.

1. Tragedy of EY employee Ms. Anna Sebastian

As you may be aware, a bright, young, ambitious lady from Kerala Anna Sebastian tragically died due to work stress. On behalf of AIPC, I visited Anna’s parents and helped organise a video call for them with Rahul Gandhi. Mr. Gandhi has promised his personal support to them and has advised me to come up with a constructive campaign to ensure we have no more Anna situations in the country.



We are working on a “For Anna For All” program to end toxic work culture and promote Work Wellness for all professionals. Details will be announced soon. This is a very very important initiative and it should be the utmost priority of every AIPC member and vertical head to participate and promote this program in their domains across the country. This will be monitored from Delhi.

2. 328 business owners and professionals in Jammu participated in an open interactive session organised by AIPC with Rahul Gandhi on September 25, 2024.

The invite-only event was three times oversubscribed and a resounding success thanks to the untiring efforts of AIPC J&K President Sanjay Sapru and the secretariat team of Khalid, Mohit and Madhumeet.
